Pakistan Bait ul Mal

Q.1 What is meant by IFA?

Ans. IFA means Individual Financial Assistance to poor people, which cover Education, Medical, General Assistance and Rehabilitation

Q.2 What is FSP?

Ans. FSP stands for Food Support Program, beneficiary of this program are `enrolled from all over the Pakistan district office wise.

Q.3 What is CSP?

Ans. Child Support Programme is an add-on programme of Food Support Programme it is an incentive for poor to send their children to school and get paid for it.

Q.4 What is NCRCL?

Ans. NCRCL stands for National Centers for Rehabilitation of Child Labour; purpose of NCRCL is to wean away children from the hazardous child labour environment.

Q.5 What is the incentive for students enrolled in NCRCL? (National Centre for Rehabilitation of Child Labour)?

Ans: (i) Free uniform which is given 4 times a year.
(ii) Rs.300/-per month, education stipend (wage compensation)
(iii) Free medical check up
(iv) Parents Subsistence allowance (Rs.300/-per month)
(v) Free haircut once a month.

Q.6 What is the incentive for trainees enrolled in Vocational Dastkari? Schools?

Ans: (i) Rs.10/-per day.
(i) Award of sewing machines to all students at the completion of their course along with a Holy Quran.

Q.7 Is their any vocational training for the students of NCRCL?

Ans: Vocational training is to be imparted to the students of class 4th and 5th.

Q.8 What will be the future of the passed out student of NCRCL.

Ans: They will be given Rs.4100/-per annum as educational stipend upto class 8th. Financial assistance will be given through the other scheme of PBM i.e.(IFA) for the education above Middle Level.

Q.9 What is DVDS?

Ans. DVDS is Diversified Vocational Dastkari Schools, DVDS has been established where training in latest marketable skills like computer, beautician, cooking, beverage, and fishing etc is imparted to semi educated female with a view that they anticipate the future needs.

Q.10 What are the skills imparted at DVDS?

Ans: Besides, dress designing /making, machine and hand Embroidery, beautician & parlor management, fabric Painting, computer training, cooking and baking, book Binding, handicrafts, candle making, soap making and Home management skills are imparted at DVDS.

Q.11 Are boys & girls both eligible for enrolment under NCRCL (National Centre for Rehabilitation of Child Labour)?

Ans: Yes, (deserving poor children) male and female both are eligible.

Q.12 Beside free education in NCRCL, are the enrolled children Eligible for free medical help as well?

Ans: Yes, sick and ailing poor child students can also receive free Medical help facilities.

Q.13 On completion of training do the trainees also get jobs in VDS/DVDS?

Ans: Not necessarily. However, if vacancy is available preference is given to the passed out students of VDS/DVDS.

Q.14 Does the VDS (Vocational Dastkari School) also provide Computer training?

Ans: Yes, at DVDS (Diversified Vocational Dastkari School) most market oriented skills are provided such as IT-Training.

Q.15 What is PBM?

Ans. PBM Stands for Pakistan Bait ul Mal, PBM is working to improve the social set up and to minimize the gap between “haves” and “have-nots”.
